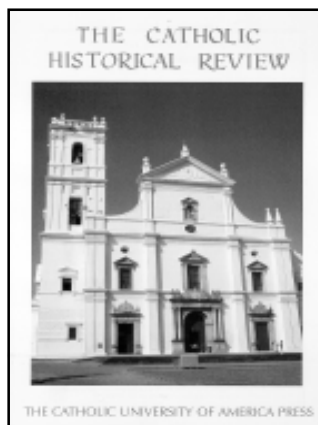


### The Americas
